

# Ms. Jenna



Ms. Jenna has been studying dance since she was three years old and became a member of the First Position Scarlettes Dance Company when she was six years old. Throughout her years as a Scarlette she received numerous scholarships, special performance invitations, overall high scoring awards and judges awards for her groups, solos and duets including a scholarship to The American Musical and Dramatic Academy (AMDA) in New York City. Ms. Jenna taught at First Position School of Dance for several years working with students of all ages. She supplemented her training by attending various dance conventions in the TriState Area and taking many classes at Broadway Dance Center in New York City.

During her time on the EBHS Varsity Gymnastics team, she experienced numerous championships including the GMC conference title and the Central NJ Sectional title. She was also chosen to be on the East Brunswick High School Dance Team for three years where she was named captain her senior year. Ms. Jenna was the choreographer for the EBHS Dance Team and the East Brunswick Young Adult Charity Players (EBYACP) benefit performance ensemble.

After high school graduation, Ms. Jenna attended the University of Delaware (UD) where she was a four year member and captain of the award winning, nationally ranked University of Delaware Dance Team. During her time on the UD Dance Team she performed at sporting events and promotional events around her campus and the east coast, and worked closely with renowned choreographers such as Joshua “Hazmat” Ulep, AJ “Headache” Pak and Denise DiCharry. Her team won two national titles at the UDA College National Championships, in 2018 for Jazz and in 2019 for Hip Hop. Ms. Jenna represented the UD Dance team at Pro Action Dance Intensive in Las Vegas, a two day dance convention for college and professional dance teams. She took masterclasses and learned choreography from various professional choreographers and dancers such as NappyTabs, Shandon Perez, Sabrina Bryan, Oscar Perez, Robert Rich and Michelle Vaughn. She was selected as team representative for multiple athletic organizations at the university. Throughout her four years at UD she took various dance classes to further develop her appreciation for dance as an art and learn about the history of dance. Additionally, Ms. Jenna has worked as the gymnastics specialist for LakeView Day Camp where she taught children of all ages and skill levels the fundamentals of gymnastics.
